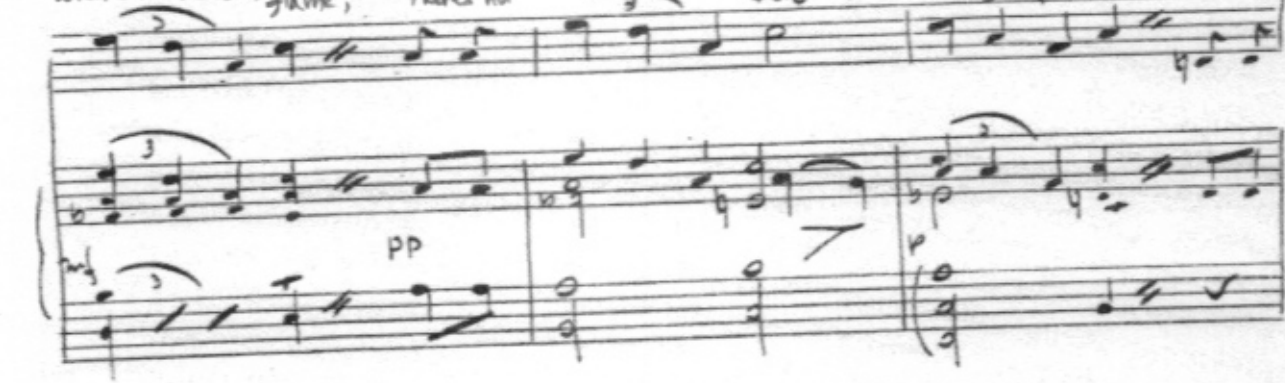
(Verse) My heart was light-ed by the flame of your love.

with-out a moon

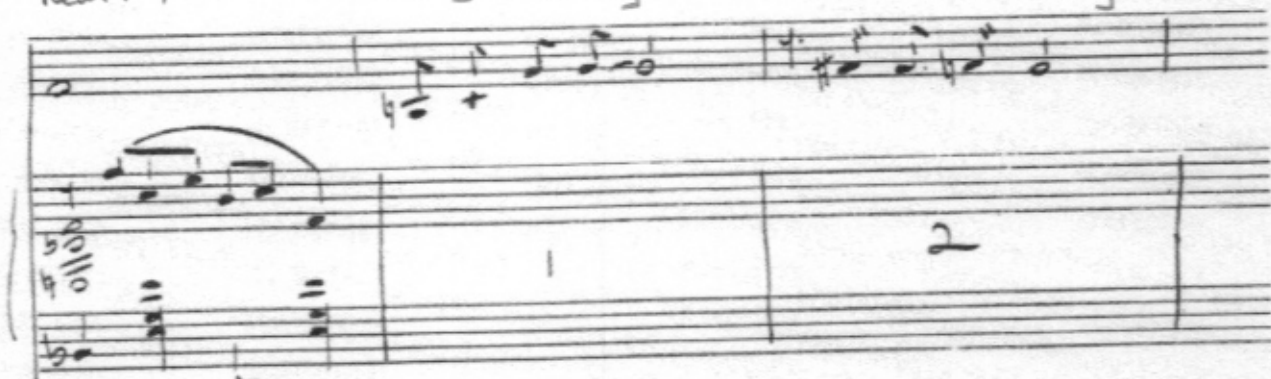
