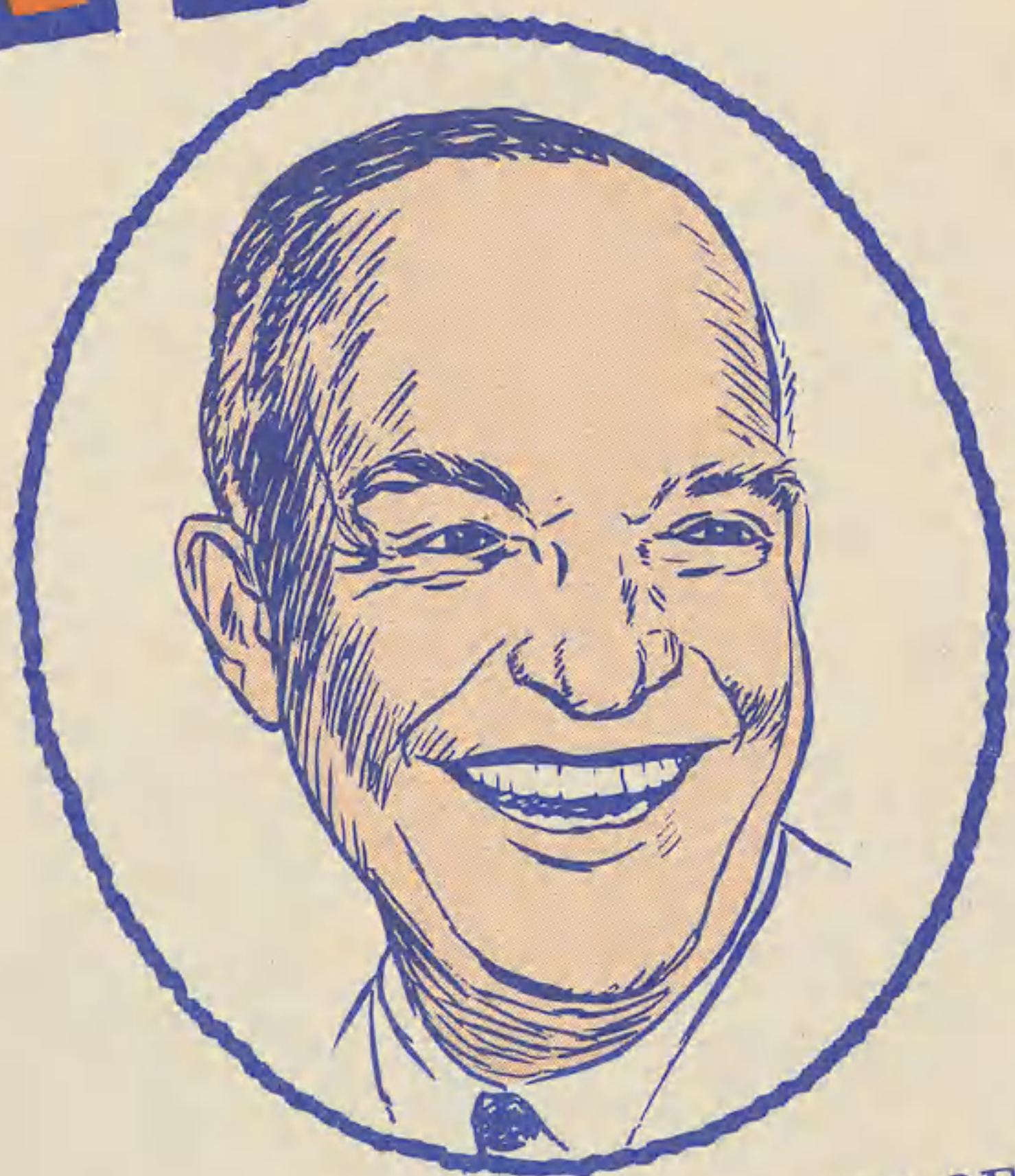

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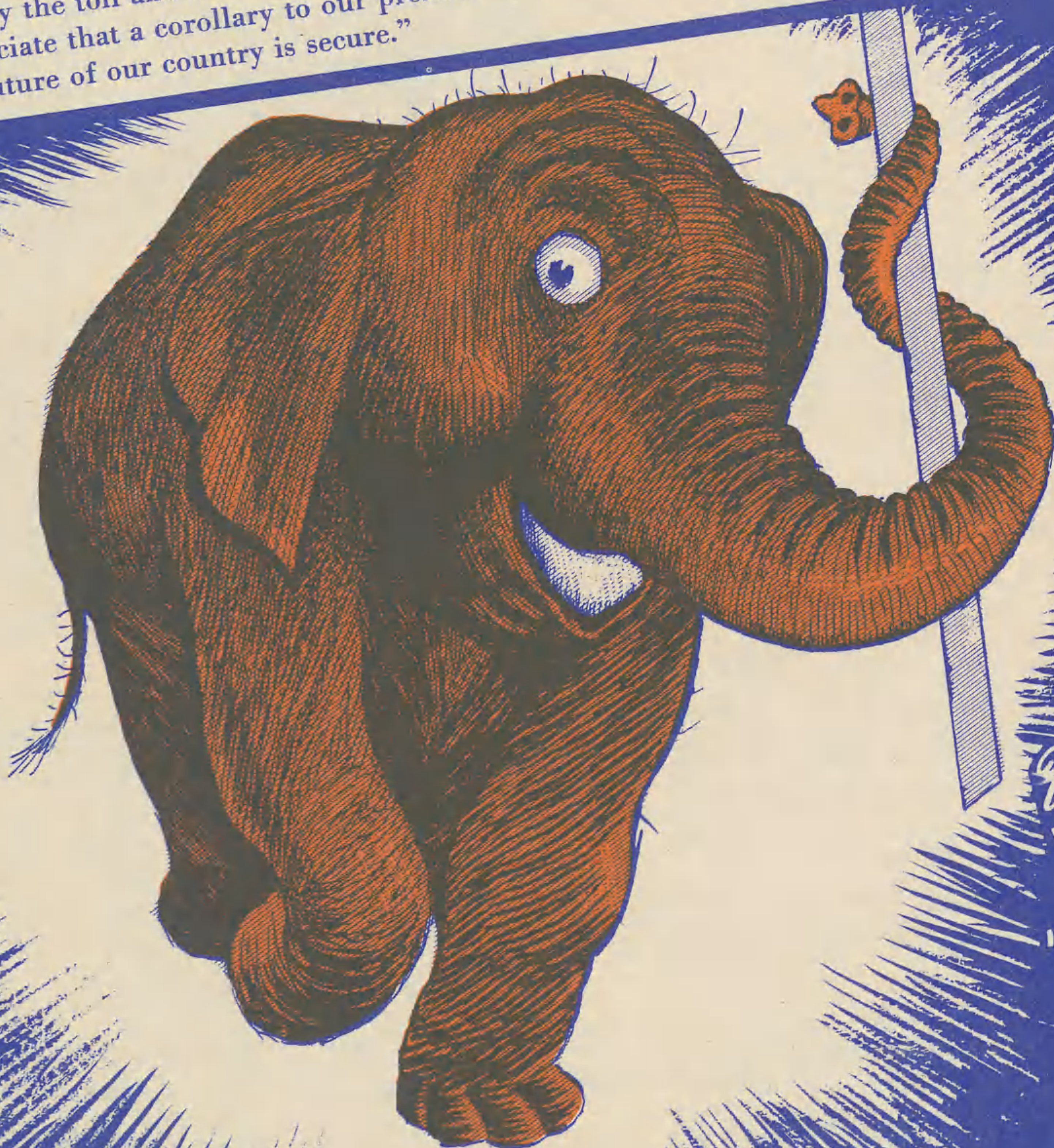

# "HIKE WITH IKE!"

Originated and Introduced by

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## STEP 1

**SLOW PICK UP "HIKE" – ALL SWAY LEFT  
"WITH" – ALL SWAY RIGHT**

- (A) All start with left foot and walk forward four (4) steps, counting cadence: One, Two, Three, Four.
- (B) Two Step – Left and Right – chanting, "Hike With Ike, Hike With Ike!"

## STEP 2

**(C) STAR BY THE RIGHT –**

All turn center of their group of four and join right hands. Repeat A and B of Step 1 – **only** the circle travels clock-wise.

**(D) STAR BY THE LEFT –**

All turn and join left hands – Repeat A and B of Step 1, but travel counter-clock-wise. Finish in original starting position.

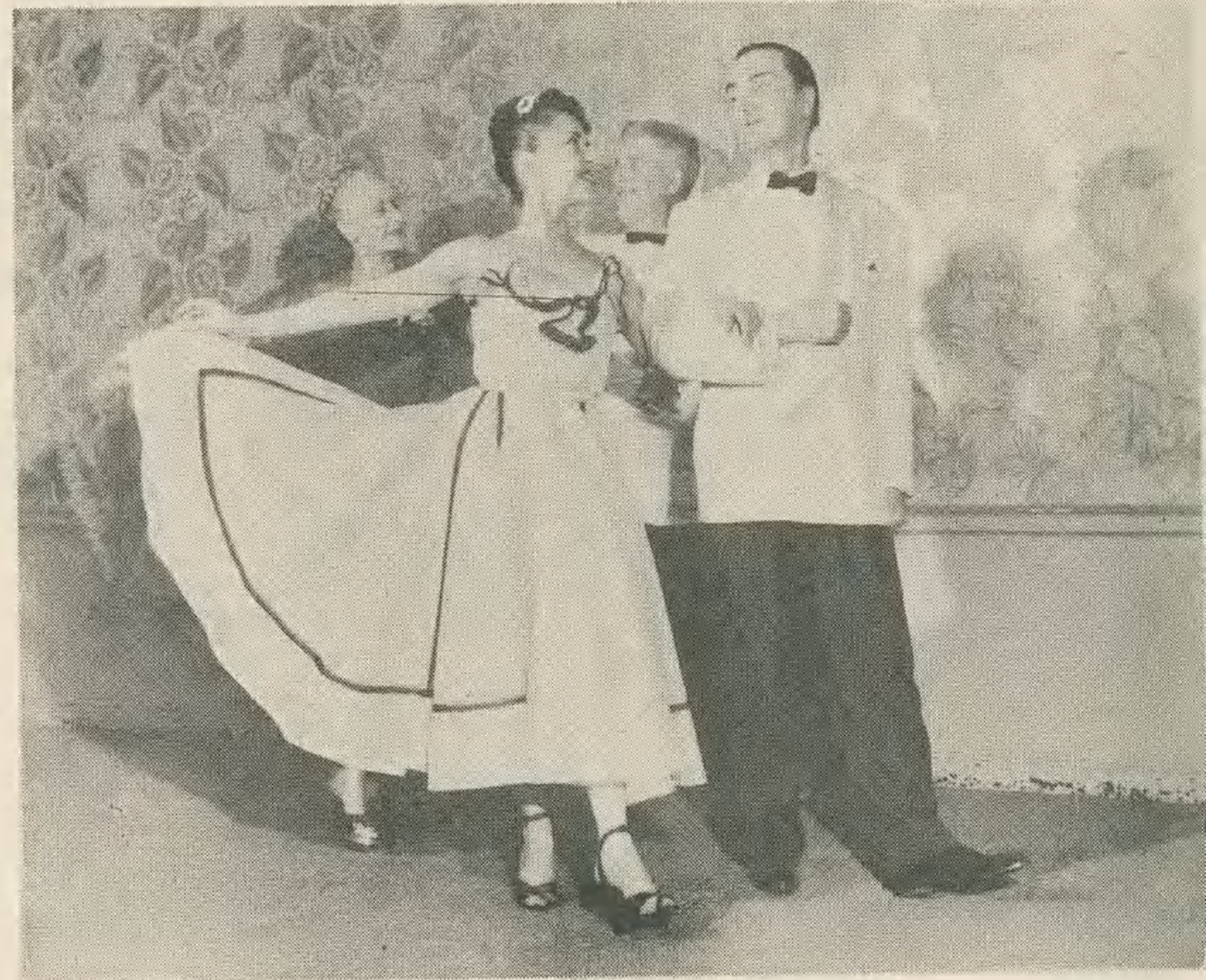
## STEP 3

**OVER THE TOP**

**Couple No. 1** – step close together and bend knees – marking time – WHILE COUPLE No. 2 joins gentlemen's Right and Lady's left hand in an arch, and walks forward taking arch over the top of couple No. 1 with four (4) steps. Then all do a two-step left and two-step right.

**Couple No. 2** – Step close together marking time – And couple No. 2 makes the arch and goes over the top of couple No. 1 with four steps. Then all do a two-step left and two-step right. Finish in original starting position, and chant:

"Over the Top, Over the Top,  
Over the Top with Ike!"
